MISSION SUNDAY

World Mission Sunday is the Holy Father's annual appeal for spiritual and financial support so that the life-giving work of overseas mission and missionaries can continue. It always falls on the second last Sunday in October, meaning this year it will be celebrated over the weekend of Sunday 22nd October. (Next Weekend). The second Collection at all Masses next weekend will be for the Missions.



The theme for this year's celebration of Mission Sunday is: "Hearts on Fire, Feet on the Move" (Luke 24: 13-35).

OCTOBER 18TH, FEAST OF SAINT LUKE

Tradition holds that before the Evangelist Luke joined Paul in his missionary work, he made his living as a physician. His Gospel and its "companion volume", the Acts of the Apostles, give evidence of Luke's classical education and careful attention to detail. Luke shows a particular sensitivity to the hidden movements of the heart; his is the only Gospel to relate the parables of the Good Samaritan and the Prodigal Son. He also speaks much about Our Lady in the opening chapters of his Gospel. In his encyclical Dives in misericordia (Rich in Mercy) Saint John Paul II calls Luke the "Gospel of Mercy".

Adoration
