Saint of the Week. St Laurence O'Toole. November 14th.

Also known as Lorcán Ua Tuathail, he was born at Castledermot, Kildare, Ireland. He was elected archbishop of Dublin in 1161 – he was the first elected archbishop, since his predecessor, Gregory, had already been bishop of Dublin when the city was raised to an archbishopric. He was the first Irish bishop of Dublin, and also the last one before the Reformation: Ireland was invaded by the Normans in 1170 and his successors were all Normans or Englishmen. He took part in the negotiations consequent on the invasion, and negotiated with Henry II of England. Forbidden for a while to return to Ireland after being made a papal legate by the Pope in Rome, he eventually persuaded Henry II to let him return, but he died on the journey, at Eu in Normandy. He is Co Patron of our Diocese with St Kevin of Glendalough.

FUNERAL MINISTRY The Archbishop has asked that every Parish should have a Funeral Ministry Team. This Team will assist the priest in the celebration of the Funeral Rites, and as the number of priests declines members of the team may eventually lead a funeral outside of the celebration of the Eucharist. Those who might be interested, and who have sufficient training in ministry are asked to see Fr Michael.

SHARE APPEAL SUNDAY

This Sunday we are asked to think about how we support the Second Collection at Mases- also known as the Share Collection. This collection helps the Archbishop to run the Diocese which now employs many more Lay People, and some of the money collected goes towards Parishes who cannot generate enough income to survive.
